* Community Impact (max. 35 points)

- Equity-focus, reflects diversity & inclusion, community-centered (driven/informed)
- Demonstrates significant collaboration with others (orgs/agencies, associations/networks, cross- or multi-sector)
- Clearly demonstrates equity approaches (health equity, racial equity, for examples)
- Proposal is well aligned and clearly addresses priorities stated in Guidelines (focus, priorities, etc.)

* Feasibility (max. 15 points)

• Likelihood of meeting objectives & awareness of influencing factors

* Outcomes Measurement/Evaluation (max. 15 points)

- Well-chosen, measurable objectives
- Effective outcome measurement (quantitative and qualitative)

* Serves Focus Area (max. 15 points)

 This work effectively addresses an unmet need in the NNMHGG grant making geographic area

* Budget (max. 15 points)

 Cost effective (makes a clear association between proposed expenses/costs and the desired outcomes)

* Discretionary Points (max. 10)
