

## Summary

Con Alma Health Foundation provides grants to eligible nonprofits working to improve health and advance health equity for people who live in New Mexico.





## 2025 Grant Cycles

#### Multi-Year CLOSED 4/15/2025

Statewide

\$30,000; \$40,000; \$50,000 for up to 3 years

Must be able to demonstrate 3 years of successful operations

Larger Systemic Change with a focus on Policy, Advocacy and Capacity Building

#### Annual

Statewide

\$15,000, \$20,000, \$25,000, \$30,000 for one year

Funding: 26-30 requests

Reviewed by Community Reviewers and Grant Making Committee

#### Northern NM Health

Los Alamos, Rio Arriba, and Northern Santa Fe Counties

\$10,000, \$15,000 or \$20,000 for one year

**Funding: 6-10 requests** 

Reviewed by CAHF and Los Alamos Hospital Auxiliary

## Eligibility Criteria

**Priority Communities** 

Marginalized because of race, language, gender, disability, sexual orientation, or spiritual beliefs

Immigrant, rural, and border communities

Low-income and economically underresourced communities

People suffering from chronic health conditions and trauma-related health inequities

People who are uninsured, underinsured, and/or medically underserved



## Eligibility Criteria

Tax-exempt, nonprofit 501(c)(3), or fiscal sponsor

Current and past grant recipients may apply

Must benefit people living in New Mexico

If work is to be completed on tribal area, applying organization must get a tribal letter of support.



## Eligibility Criteria

The Foundation supports requests that have the potential to benefit many members in a system, network, or community (vs. individual needs).

Northern NM Grants ONLY: Open to programs in Rio Arriba, Los Alamos and Outside City Limits of Santa Fe County.



## Applying Through a Fiscal Sponsor

Projects, non-profits, public or governmental agency or a federally recognized tribe in the state of New Mexico without IRS 501(c)(3) designation may apply through a fiscal sponsor.

If using a fiscal sponsor, the organization serving as fiscal sponsor must have verifiable 501(c)(3) status from the IRS and a current organization profile in CAHF's grant portal.



## Exclusions/Restrictions

Political campaigns, political lobbying, or other partisan activities prohibited by section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code

Support to individuals, scholarships, or fellowships

Capital or endowment campaigns, annual fundraising campaigns, event sponsorships, debt liquidation, or clinical research

Grants to organizations that discriminate based on race, ancestry, national or ethnic origin, disability, sex, age, religion, sexual orientation, or gender identity

Grants made for religious purposes

Grants for construction, renovation, or repairs



## Use of Funds / Allowable Costs


Con Alma Grants: Up to \$30.000

Northern NM Health Grants: Up to \$20,000

Funds may be used for personnel (staffing/benefits), professional services (contractors, evaluators), operational expenses (supplies, printing, postage, copying, communications), meetings and travel (venue rental, training costs), and other direct and indirect expenses.

Purchases of property or equipment are limited to \$5,000 per item.

## Application Questions

- Need for Funding/Opportunity (Why is this funding needed now?) 100 words
- People to Benefit (Who will benefit from this funding?) 100 words
- Beneficiary Participation (How will you engage people who benefit from this work?) 100 words
- Health Equity (How will funding this grant promote health equity?) 100 words
- Activities to be Funded (What are the activities to be funded?) 350 words
- Organizational Capacity (What qualities of your organization (resources, skills, experience, etc.) will help accomplish the work proposed?) 100 words
- Community Resources (How will other community resources be used in this work?) 100 words
- **Proposed Outcomes and Their Impact** (What are the expected outcomes of this work?) 200 words
- Measuring or Reporting Outcomes (How will you know you have achieved the expected outcomes?) 150 words
- Long Term Impact (What long-term changes do you expect from this work?) 150 words




#### Grant Seekers



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
